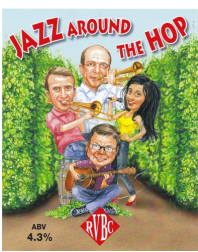

Jazz Around the Hop

(4.3% ABV)

The Rother Valley Brewing Company brings you this year's Festival Ale. It's a jazzy little number from the trumpet player!

Star (4.3% ABV)

Amber

Portobello Brewery, London.

The accepted wisdom holds that the six pointed brewer's star represents the essential ingredients in any brew: water, grain, hops, yeast, malt, and the brewer. **Star** is the first beer ever brewed by Portobello Brewery. It's a smooth, balanced bitter, which is deliciously floral with lovely coffee notes at the very end.



Rutland Osprey (4.0% ABV) Blonde

The Grainstore Brewery, Oakham, Rutland.

A refreshing light golden brew, whose flavour is complex and mellow with a finely balanced floral aroma and smooth bitterness.



Pressed Rat and Warthog

(3.8% ABV)

Dark Mild

Triple FFF Brewery, Hampshire.

Ruby coloured, coffee and chocolate aroma with hints of dried fruits and sour cherry leads to a soft yet full roast flavour, fruit and malt vying with the rounded hoppy bittersweet finish. Not only for the mild fanatics but the bitter lovers too!



Heel Stone (4.3% ABV)

Stonehenge Ales Ltd, Wiltshire Deep Amber

A crisp clean, refreshing, bitter. Deep amber in colour, well balanced with a fruity blackcurrant nose. Bitter flavour.



Bramling Cross (4.2%)

Pale Golden

Broughton Ales, Scotland

This light golden coloured ale is brewed using only Pale Ale Malt and Bramling Cross hops for both aroma and bitterness. A light refreshing ale with a good hop bitterness and aroma on a background of malt sweetness.



Waterloo Rye IPA (6.1% ABV)

Harveys, Lewes.

100 Firkins have been produced to mark the 200th Anniversary of the Battle of Waterloo. Key ingredients used in the brewing process of this beer have been carefully selected to mark the Anniversary.



Yaffle (4.1%)

Pale

West Berkshire Brewery.

Pale in colour with a full hop flavour, an ideal beer for sipping in the sunshine.



Scrumdiggit (4.0%)

Mid Brown

Goddards Brewery, Isle Of Wight.

A harvest bronze Golden Ale, brewed with Challenger, East Kent Goldings and Fuggles hops to give a fruity citrus bite of hoppiness with a palate of citrus notes and vanilla, leading to a long dry finish.



Ferryman's Gold (4.4% ABV)

Gold

Loddon Brewery, Oxfordshire.

Brewed using Slovenian Styrian Golding hops which impart a zesty lime flavour. The mix of Cara malt and Wheat malt give a smooth, creamy body to the beer.



Golden Duck (5.1% ABV)

Gold

Weltons Brewery, Horsham, West Sussex.

Golden clear wheat beer. Sweet with a huge chewy aroma with hints of oranges.



Amberescent (4.0%)

Copper

Isfield Brewing Company, Isfield, East Sussex(4.0%)

A copper coloured pale ale with a toffee and fruit nose, caramel and malty taste with a rounded finish.



Farmers Delight (3.9% ABV)

Verulam Brewery, St Albans, Herts.

Farmer's Delight has a sharp citrus bitterness with a chewy malt finish.



Oast House (4.8% ABV) Blonde

Whitepark Brewery, Bedfordshire.

Golden, bitter, well hopped, zesty pale ale. Made from a variety of hops for a refreshing drinking experience.

Wise Owl Cider (6% ABV)

Wise Owl Cider, High Halden, Ashford

Winner of Best Cider at The Taste of Kent Awards 2015 and Best Cider or Perry at the recent CAMRA KESR Festival in Tenterden.

Made from 100% Kentish apple juice. Eight different varieties of apple are blended to make a light and flavoursome cider with no added water or sugar.
